
# Licensing Statistics of 600-series and 9x515 Items

October 15, 2013 to December 31, 2017


The license applications for items in the 18 categories of the United States Munitions List (USML) showed an overall average decline of 51.2 % from 4,811 to 2,346 per month through December 31, 2017. The average monthly drop of 2,465 in license applications is the result of certain items that do not warrant control on the USML transitioning to the Commerce Control List (CCL). The biggest drop in license applications was those impacted by the fourth regulatory change involving the transition of satellites with a 84.4% decline. The Directorate of Defense Trade Controls (DDTC) of the U.S. Department of State estimates a 45% decline in license applications will be shown when all USML categories have been reviewed.

# BIS Average Monthly Applications by USML to CCL Regulatory Change October 15, 2013 to December 31, 2017



From October 15, 2013 to December 31, 2017, BIS has processed a total of 56,159<sup>1</sup> applications for 600-series and 9x515 items. Of these, 52,305 applications were for 600-series items and 3,854 were for 9x515 items.


### Of 52,305 applications for 600-series items:

- Approved applications were 46,788, 89.5% of the total applications;
- Returned without action (RWA) were 5,380, 10.3% of the total; and
- Denied applications were 137, 0.3% of the total.

# Of 3,854 applications for 9x515 items:

- Approved applications were 3,130, 81.2% of the total applications;
- Returned without action (RWA) were 641, 16.6% of the total; and
- Denied applications were 83, 2.2% of the total.


# BIS License Applications for 600-Series and 9x515 Items by Total Count Effective Date to December 31, 2017

BIS License Applications for 600-Series and 9x515 Items by Decisions


Effective Date to December 31, 2017

# BIS Yearly License Applications for 600-Series and 9x515 Items by Transition Rule

From October 15, 2013 to December 31, 2017, BIS has processed applications for 600-series and 9x515 items for a value of \$246.1 billion. Of these, \$124.0 billion for 600-series items and \$122.1 for 9x515 items.


#### Of \$124.0 billion for 600-sereis items:

- Approved applications valued at \$113.1 billion, 91.2% of the total application value;
- Returned without action (RWA) valued at \$10.3 billion, 8.3% of the total; and
- Denied applications valued at \$544.9 million, 0.4% of the total.

#### Of \$122.1 billion for 9x515 items:


- Approved applications valued at \$121.1 billion, 95.2% of the total application value;
- Returned without action (RWA) valued at \$967 million, 4.6% of the total; and
- Denied applications valued at \$604.5 million, 0.2% of the total.

# BIS License Applications for 600-Series and 9x515 Items by Value Effective Date to December 31, 2017 \$million



In the last 13 months from December 2016 to December 2017, the average monthly BIS license approvals for all ECCNs are 2,565, indicating an increase of 50.9% from the average monthly approvals of 1,700 during the fiscal year 2012 to 2013, prior to the first regulatory change from the USML to the CCL becoming effective:

- For 600-Series items, the average monthly license approvals are 1,084;
- $\triangleright$  For 9x515 items are 86; and
- For legacy ECCNs are 1,395.




## Top Destinations of BIS Approved Licenses for 600-Series Items

Of the total 46,788 BIS approved licenses for 600-series items from October 15, 2013 to December 31, 2017, 31,090 (66.4% of the total approved licenses) were issued for exports to the top 15 destinations by license count. The top destinations were Japan with 5,574 approved licenses (11.9% of the total); the United Kingdom with 4,810 (10.3%), and South Korea with 2,538 (5.4%).
