


License Applications and Exports

The First USML to CCL Regulatory Change

Aircraft and Gas Turbine Engines

October 15, 2013 to March 31, 2018


The license applications for items in categories VIII (Aircraft) and XIX (Gas Turbine Engines) of the United States Munitions List (USML) have declined 67.1% from an average of 1,513 to 497 per month through March 31, 2018. The average monthly drop of 1,016 in license applications is the result of certain items transitioning to the Commerce Control List (CCL).

Since the first USML to CCL regulatory change became effective on October 15, 2013, the average number of BIS processed licenses for the ten 600-Series items created by this rule is 642 per month through March 31, 2018. The approval rate is 90.5%.

 October 15, 2013 to March 31, 2018



From October 15, 2013 to March 31, 2018, U.S. exports of items under the first USML to CCL regulatory change – Aircraft and Gas Turbine Engines items (9x610 and 9y619) under BIS jurisdiction totaled 281,659 shipments for \$14.8 billion.

 under BIS Jurisdiction**





Of the \$14.8 billion in U.S. exports of 600-series items in the first USML to CCL regulatory change under BIS jurisdiction from October 15, 2013 to March 31, 2018, licensed exports totaled \$7.2 billion (48.6% of the total); Servicing and replacement of parts and equipment totaled \$1.8 billion (12.3%) and No License Required to Canada totaled \$1.7 billion (11.2%).

BIS License Exceptions:

RPL: Servicing and replacement of parts and equipment

NLR: No License Required

STA: Strategic Trade Authorization

GOV: Governments, international organizations, international inspections under the Chemical Weapons Convention, and the International Space Station

TMP: Temporary imports, exports, reexports, and transfers (in-country)

LVS: Shipments of limited value
