


## License Applications and Exports

### The Fifth USML to CCL Regulatory Change

#### Military Electronics

December 30, 2014 to June 30, 2018


The license applications for items in category XI – Military Electronics of the United States Munitions List (USML) have declined 55.2% from an average of 1,320 to 591 per month through June 30, 2018. The average monthly drop of 729 license applications is the result of certain items transitioning to the Commerce Control List (CCL).

Since the fifth USML to CCL regulatory change became effective on December 30, 2014, the average number of BIS license applications for the eight 600-Series items created by this rule is 268 per month through June 30, 2018. The approval rate is 88.1%.

From the effective date of December 30, 2014 to June 30, 2018, U.S. exports of items in the fifth USML to CCL regulatory change – Military Electronics items (3y611 and 9y620) under BIS jurisdiction totaled 38,734 shipments for \$2.6 billion.



Of the \$2.6 billion in U.S. exports of 600-series items in the fifth USML to CCL regulatory change under BIS jurisdiction from December 30, 2014 to June 30, 2018, licensed exports totaled \$994.0 million (38.6% of the total); Strategic Trade Authorization (STA) totaled \$681.1 million (26.5%) and Servicing and replacement of parts and equipment (RPL) totaled \$294.4 million (11.4%).

**BIS License Exceptions:**

STA: Strategic Trade Authorization

RPL: Servicing and replacement of parts and equipment

GOV: Governments, international organizations, international inspections under the Chemical Weapons Convention, and the International Space Station

NLR: No License Required

TMP: Temporary imports, exports, reexports, and transfers (in-country)
