
### The Second USML to CCL Regulatory Change Vehicles and Vessels

January 6, 2014 to September 30, 2019

Since the second USML to CCL regulatory change became effective on January 6, 2014, BIS has processed a total of 8,196 license applications for a value of \$16.5 billion for the nineteen 600-Series items created by this rule through September 30, 2019. The average number of BIS license applications for is 119 per month. BIS has approved a total of 6,881 licenses for a value of \$13.7 billion and the approval rate is 84.0%.



From January 6, 2014 to September 30, 2019, U.S. exports of items in the second USML to CCL regulatory change – Vehicles and Vessels items (0y606, 8y609, 8y620 and 0y617) under BIS jurisdiction totaled 45,657 shipments for \$2.3 billion.



Of the \$2.3 billion in U.S. exports of 600-series items in the second USML to CCL regulatory change under BIS jurisdiction from January 6, 2014 to September 30, 2019, licensed exports totaled \$1.4 billion (60.2% of the total); No License Required (NLR) for .y 600-series items totaled \$446.8 million (19.1%); and NLR for 600-series items to Canada totaled \$189.2 million (8.1%).

Weapons Convention and the International Space Station

STA: Strategic Trade Authorization

RPL: Servicing and replacement of parts and equipment

TMP: Temporary imports, exports, reexports, and transfers (in-country)

LVS: Shipments of limited value
